

HC KIDS REOPENING

MINISTRY SEPTEMBER 13, 2020



SERVICE TIMES

- HC Kids Ministry will be offered during our Sunday 9:00 am & 10:45 am worship gathering only.
- Child(ren) can attend **one** HC Kids Ministry service unless their parent/guardian is serving.

CLASSES

- Infant/Crawler
- Walker
- Toddler 1
- Toddler 2
- PreK 1
- PreK 2
- Kinders
- 1st-4th Grade

Children are grouped by their graduating class once they enter the Toddler 1 room.

CHECK IN

- Check In will be from 8:45-9:15am & 10:30-11:00am.
- Children will be screened upon checking in. Screening will include self assessment and temperature check.
- We ask that if your child or a member of your household is feeling ill or showing any symptoms of COVID-19 that you stay at home and participate in HC Kids online.
- We ask that only 1 parent/guardian checks their child(ren) in to allow room for social distancing and limit exposure.
- Parents/Guardians will use 2 separate doors upon entering and exiting.

CHECK OUT

- Check Out will begin promptly following services. We ask that you come to pick up your child(ren) as soon as possible to allow time for our volunteers to sanitize.
- We ask that only 1 parent/guardian checks their child(ren) out to allow room for social distancing and limit exposure.
- Parents/Guardians will use 2 separate doors upon entering and exiting.

KEEPING HC KIDS SAFE

- All ministry rooms and areas will be cleaned before, between, and following services.
- Each room will have hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the room.
- Ministry Rooms & activities have been organized to make learning about Jesus engaging, while being safe and sanitary.
- Class sizes will **not** be limited, however classes have been reorganized and remodeled to allow more space.
- The previous 3-Kindergarten area is now broken down into 3 classes. These classes will no longer rotate to keep from spreading germs.
- Volunteers & any child(ren) 10 years & older will be asked to wear a mask when not social distancing.
- Each Ministry room has a sanitation bucket to place any toys/supplies that a child coughs, sneezes, or puts in their mouth. These toys/supplies will not be used until they are properly sanitized.
- Toys & Supplies that cannot be sanitized between services will only be used during one service.
- When/If a child or volunteer presents symptoms parent/guardian will be notified immediately. Room will be sanitized and other parents will be notified according to AR Department of Health's guidelines.

SNACK

- Snack Time will only be provided for children attending both service times.
- Snacks will be individually wrapped and each child will have their own space to eat.
- Infant, Walkers, & Crawlers may bring their own food & drink and when appropriate volunteers will feed them.
- Toddlers may bring a labeled sippy cup to drink as needed.

VOLUNTEERS

- Volunteers will be screened upon arrival. Screening will include self assessment and temperature check.
- Volunteers will wear masks while caring for your child(ren).
- Volunteers will be asked to serve on a monthly basis to limit additional exposure.
