



“The Flipside of Heaven” - May 5th

What activities do you enjoy here on earth (hiking, golf, fishing, etc.) that you hope you'll also get to enjoy in heaven? How might these experiences be even better in heaven?

What do you think are some common misconceptions about heaven?

Read Revelation 21:4-7

What pain are you experiencing today that will be absent in heaven? Does that help you in dealing with the pain? Why or why not?

Is it possible to imagine life without sin and betrayal?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:1-9

In what ways are you comforted by the knowledge that something better is waiting for you after death?

What do you anticipate about being at home with the Lord? How will your heavenly home be a better place? (**vs 6**)

How does vs 7 remind us of how we are supposed to live as Christians? Why is this an important dimension to our lives as believers?

How can our current understanding of what heaven will be like affect our life right now?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:15

The flip side of heaven for believers is now, our life on this earth. How does this passage put into perspective our responsibilities after salvation?

We got to experience communion (The Lord's Supper) together as a church. Jesus tells us to do this as a way to remember him and reflect on the sacrifice that he made for us. He tells the disciples in **Matthew 26:29** that he will take this supper with them again in heaven. How does it make you feel to know that one day you will get to experience communion with Christ face to face?

Spend some time as a group reflecting on heaven and the time we shared as a church in communion. Pray together that we would be motivated by the sacrifice that Christ made to live out our faith so others may come to know him.
